AIM Academy is excited to launch its first-ever school yearbook, facilitated by Sara Marchione and created by AIM students. This project will provide students with meaningful opportunities to lead the creative process through capturing photos, writing stories, designing layouts, and managing production while building collaboration, leadership, and technical skills. The finished yearbook will serve as a lasting record of student voices and achievements, celebrating the unique spirit and culture of AIM Academy and leaving a legacy for years to come.

AIM Academy is planning to create its first-ever school yearbook, facilitated by staff member Sara Marchione and led by student involvement at every stage of the process. We will use accessible digital tools for layout and design, provide training in photography and storytelling, and dedicate time within advisory and enrichment blocks for students to collaborate.

This project directly benefits AIM Academy students by giving them opportunities to develop real-world skills such as teamwork, project management, creativity, and communication. Overall, it will also strengthen their sense of belonging and pride in their school community. The yearbook is particularly meaningful in an alternative high school setting, where many students have not previously seen themselves represented in such a way. By documenting their experiences and celebrating their achievements, the yearbook will build positive school culture and lasting memories for students and families.

We hope to accomplish two goals: first, to produce a high-quality yearbook that authentically reflects the voices and experiences of AIM Academy students; and second, to equip students with transferable skills they can carry into future academic, career, and personal endeavors. We will know this project is a success if students are actively engaged in the creation process, demonstrate growth in leadership and technical skills, and express pride in both the finished yearbook and their contributions to it. Feedback from students, families, and staff will serve as indicators of success, along with the sustainability of a yearbook tradition in future years.


